GET OUT OF YOUR TENTS (IT'S NOT ABOUT YOUR TENT)



Hag 1:2 "This is what the LORD of the Heavenly Armies says: 'These people keep saying, "No, the right time for rebuilding the LORD's Temple has not yet come.'"

Hag 1:4 "Is it the right time for all of you to live in your own panelled houses while this house remains in ruins?"

Hag 1:5 "Now this is what the LORD of the Heavenly Armies, says: 'Carefully consider your ways:

Hag 1:6 You have sowed much but have reaped little. You have eaten but don't have enough to become satisfied. You have drunk but don't have enough to become intoxicated. You have clothed yourself but don't have enough to keep warm. And the hired labourer deposits his salary in a bag full of holes!"

Hag 1:7 "This is what the LORD of the Heavenly Armies says: 'Carefully consider your ways:

Hag 1:8 Go up to the hills, bring wood and build the House. Then I will delight in it and I will be glorified," says Yhwh.

Hag 1:9 "You have looked for much, but indeed, there is little. What you have brought home, I have blown away. Why is this?"—it is a declaration of Yhwh-Tzva'ot—"because My House lies in ruins, while you are running, each to his own house.

Hag 1:12 Then Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel and Joshua son of Jehozadak, kohen gadol, and all the remnant of the people, heeded the voice of Yhwh their God and the words of Haggai the prophet, since Yhwh their God had sent him. So the people revered Yhwh.

Hag 1:13 Then Haggai, the messenger of Yhwh, spoke to the people with the message of Yhwh,

"I am with you!"—it is a declaration of Yhwh.

Hag 1:14 Then Yhwh stirred the spirit of Zerubbabel son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua son of Jehozadak, kohen gadol, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people, and they came and did work on the House of Yhwh-Tzva'ot their God,

because My House lies in ruins, while you are running, each to his own house.



Exo 35:4 Moses also said to all the congregation of Bnei-Yisrael, "This is the word which Yhwh commanded saying:

Exo 35:5 Take from among you an offering for Yhwh. Whoever has a willing heart, let him bring Yhwh's offering: gold, silver and bronze;

Exo 35:6 blue, purple and scarlet cloth; fine linen and goat hair;

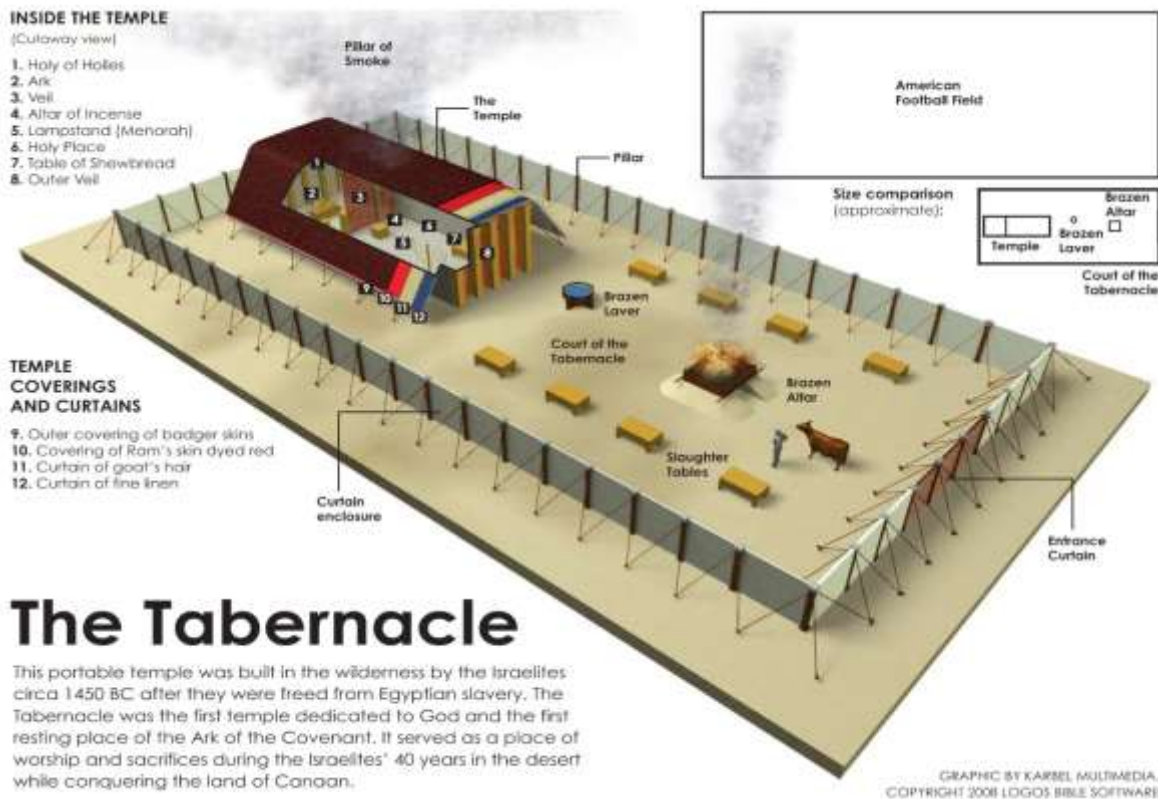
Exo 35:7 ram skins dyed red, sealskins and acacia wood;

Exo 35:8 oil for the light, spices for the anointing oil and for the sweet incense;

Exo 35:9 onyx stones, and setting stones for the ephod and for the breastplate.

Exo 35:10 "Let every wise-hearted man among you come and make everything that Yhwh has commanded, including

Exo 35:11 the Tabernacle, its tent and its covering, its clasps and its boards, its crossbars, its pillars and its bases



The Tabernacle

This portable temple was built in the wilderness by the Israelites circa 1450 BC after they were freed from Egyptian slavery. The Tabernacle was the first temple dedicated to God and the first resting place of the Ark of the Covenant. It served as a place of worship and sacrifices during the Israelites' 40 years in the desert while conquering the land of Canaan.

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Exo 35:12 the Ark and the poles, the atonement cover and the curtain screen;

Exo 35:13 the table and its poles with all of its utensils, along with the bread of the Presence;

Exo 35:14 also the menorah for light with its utensils, its lamps and the oil for the light;

Exo 35:15 the altar of incense and its poles, the anointing oil, the sweet incense, and the screen for the entrance of the Tabernacle;

Exo 35:16 the altar of burnt offering with its grating of bronze, its poles and all its utensils, the basin and its stand;

Exo 35:17 the hangings of the courtyard, the pillars and their bases, and the curtain for the gate of the courtyard;

Exo 35:18 the pegs of the Tabernacle and of the courtyard, along with their cords;

Exo 35:19 the woven garments for ministering in the holy place, the holy garments for Aaron the kohen and for his sons, to minister as kohanim."

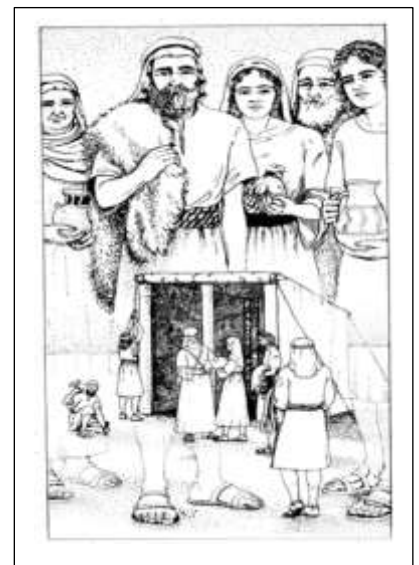
Exo 35:20 Then all the congregation of Bnei-Yisrael departed from before Moses.

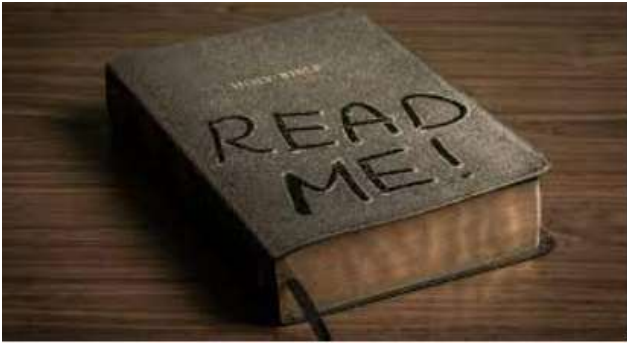
Exo 35:21 Everyone whose heart stirred him and everyone whose spirit was willing came and brought Yhwh's offering for the work of the Tent of Meeting and for all its service as well as for the holy garments.

Exo 35:22 So they came, both men and women, everyone whose heart compelled him, and brought nose rings, earrings, signet rings, bracelets, and all kinds of golden jewels—everyone who brought a wave offering of gold to Yhwh.

Exo 35:23 Everyone who had blue, purple, scarlet, fine linen, goat hair, ram skins dyed red or sealskins brought them.

Exo 35:26 All the women whose heart stirred them up with wisdom spun the goat hair.

Isa 54:2 “Enlarge the place of your tent, stretch out your tabernacle curtains. Do not hold back—lengthen your cords, strengthen your stakes.

Isa 54:3 For you will spread out to the right hand and to the left. Your offspring will possess the nations and will resettle the desolate cities.

Isa 54:4 Fear not, for you will not be ashamed. Nor cringe, for you will not be disgraced. For you will forget the shame of your youth, and you will remember the reproach of your widowhood no more.

Isa 54:5 For your Maker is your husband—Yhwh-Tzva’ot is His Name—the Holy One of Israel is your Redeemer. He will be called God of all the earth.

Isa 54:6 “For Yhwh has called you back like a wife deserted and grieved in spirit, like a wife of one’s youth that is rejected,” says your God. (remember this when we get to the Counterfeit Husband!)

Isa 54:7 “For a brief moment I deserted you, but I will regather you with great compassion.

Isa 54:10 Though the mountains depart and the hills be shaken, My love will not depart from you, nor will My covenant of peace be shaken, says Yhwh who has compassion on you.

Isa 54:11 Afflicted one, storm-tossed, unconsolated, behold, I set your stones in antimony, lay your foundations with sapphires, (remember this when we get to the great Last Day Deception)

Isa 54:12 make your pinnacles of rubies, your gates of crystal, and all your walls of precious stones.

Isa 54:14 In righteousness you will be established. You will be far from oppression—for you will not fear—and from terror—for it will not come near you. (Psalm 91)

Isa 54:15 Behold, anyone fiercely attacking is not from Me. Whoever stirs up strife with you will fall because of you.

Isa 54:16 Behold, I created the smith who blows the fire of coals and produces a weapon for its work, and I created the destroyer to ruin. **Satan was created by Him also. Satan who tested Job. Who tested Yashua. Who tested Peter and sifted him like wheat. These testings will come upon you as well. Know who it is that causes the calamity. But also know Who is allowing it. Who sits as a Refiner NEXT to the fire, while the testing is going on. Remember Dan 11 – what the end result of this testing will be.!!! (Purification of the Bride: Dan 11 v 35)**

Isa 54:17 No weapon formed against you will prosper and you will condemn every tongue that rises against you in judgment. This is the heritage of Yhwh’s servants—their vindication is from Me.” It is a declaration of Yhwh.

**Isa 54:13 your children will be taught by Yhwh. Your children will have great shalom.
SO let us older generation, prepare out children, for the time has come!!!
(Remember this when we get to the 144 000)**



Psa 132:3 "I will not enter the tent of my house nor lie on my bed,
Psa 132:4 nor will I will give sleep to my eyes, nor slumber to my eyelids,
Psa 132:5 till I find a place for Yhwh, a dwelling for the Mighty One of Jacob."
Psa 132:7 Let us go into His dwelling place, let us bow at His footstool.
Psa 132:8 Arise, Yhwh, to Your resting place—You, and the Ark of Your might.
Psa 132:9 Let Your kohanim wear righteousness, and let Your godly ones sing for joy.

1Ch 22:1 Then David said, "This is the place where the House of Yhwh Elohim will be, along with the altar for burnt sacrifices for Israel."

1Ch 22:3 David supplied an abundance of iron for nails for the doors of the gates and for the joints, so much bronze that it could not be weighed,

1Ch 22:4 and cedar logs without number,

1Ch 22:5 David said, "Solomon my son is **young and inexperienced** and the House that is to be built for Yhwh must be exceedingly magnificent, famous and glorious throughout all the nations. **Therefore I will make preparation for it.**" So David made extensive preparations before his death.

1Ch 22:6 Then He called for Solomon his son, and charged him to build a House for Yhwh, the God of Israel.

1Ch 22:11 "Now, my son, may Yhwh be with you, and may you succeed in building the House of Yhwh your God as He spoke concerning you.

1Ch 22:12 Only may Yhwh give you **insight and understanding** when He gives you charge over Israel so that you may observe the Torah of Yhwh your God. (remember this when we get to the Menorah)

1Ch 22:13 Then you will prosper, if you carefully observe the statutes and the ordinances that Yhwh commanded Moses concerning Israel. Chazak! (Be strong) And be courageous!

Do not be afraid or dismayed (my child)

1Ch 22:14 “Now behold, with great pain I have provided for the House of Yhwh 100,000 talents of gold, a million talents of silver, and bronze and iron beyond weighing for there is so much of it. I have also prepared wood and stone, and you must add to them.

1Ch 22:15 Moreover, you have an abundance of workmen: stonecutters, masons, carpenters and every kind of craftsmen skilled in every kind of material—

1Ch 22:16 in gold, silver, bronze and iron—beyond number. **Arise and work!** May Yhwh be with you.”

1Ch 22:17 David also commanded all the leaders of Israel to help Solomon his son, (Father, we pray that the leaders YOU appoint will help our children in their great Last Day work)

1Ch 22:19 Now set your hearts and souls to seek after Yhwh your God. Rise up and build the Sanctuary of Yhwh Elohim so that you can bring the Ark of the Covenant of Yhwh and the holy vessels of God into the House built for the Name of Yhwh.”

Get out of your own tents. Start building Yhwh's tent. His Tabernacle. His Temple. His City. His Kingdom. Start, because our children will have to finish it. There is no more time!!

You think the Tabernacle is only for Him??

That it is HIS?

No, all this that we think we are building for Him, is actually building for ourselves. By getting out of our tents and building His tent, we ARE actually building our own tents. Because WE are His Tent. His Tabernacle, His Kingdom. His beloved Jerusalem.

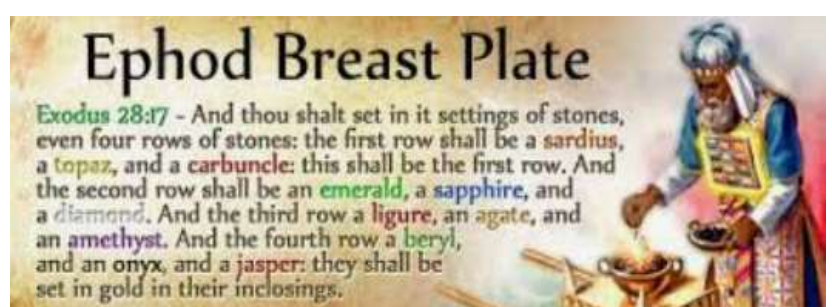
